	What does the SPIRIT of a believer experience in Heaven the instant they die?
II	Corinthians 12:2-4
Т	hese verses are actually part of Paul's defense of his authority.
•	"I know a man in Christ"
	In his effort to demonstrate, Paul spoke of this event in the third person, referring to himself as "a man in Christ." (II Corinthians 12:7)
•	"I know a man in Christ whowas caught up to the third heaven"
	The word translated "caught up" is the same word used in I Thessalonians 4:17 to describe the of the Church.
	In the O.T. , the word "heaven" was actually used to refer to 3 different realms:
	The 1 st realm is the heaven. (Isa. 55:10; Ps. 104:12)
	The 2 nd realm is the heaven. (Ps. 8:3-4; Isa. 13:10)
	The 3rd realm is the heaven. (Ps. 33:13-14; Isa. 66:1; Matt. 6:9)
•	"I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago"
	As it relates to the of this incredible experience, Paul says that it happened about fourteen years before he wrote to the Corinthians.
•	"whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows."
	I Corinthians 15:50

Before our bodies can ever enter Heaven, they first must be changed fromto by the power of God.	
When a believer dies and their spirit enters the presence of God, it will feel more than earthly life ever did or ever could!	
Although the Bible doesn't give us a comprehensive picture of everything that a believer's spirit will experience immediately after death, it does give us some incredible glimpses:	
1) At the moment of death, our spirit will be and united with Jesus Christ! (II Corinthians 5:8; Philippians 1:23)	
2) At the moment of death, our spirit will experience unimaginable and incomprehensible (Ps. 16:1; 17:15; 21:6; Phil. 1:21; Il Cor. 5:8, John 16:22)	
3) At the moment of death, our spirit will immediately experience indescribable, and (Revelation 14:13)	
4) At the moment of death, our spirit will experience unrestrained (Revelation 7:9-10; Hebrews 12:1)	
5) At the moment of death, our spirit will immediately be made, set free from the effects sin. (Hebrews 12:22-23)	
6) At the moment of death, our spirit will begin to anxiously await our resurrected and glorified (I Corinthians 15:50-55; I Thessalonians 4:16-17)	
Right now , in Heaven, believers exist in a spiritual state, perfectly conscious and joyful, while awaiting their resurrected and glorified body.
